



# Cumberland and Perry County School Food Programs

## **Big Spring School District**

Families were encouraged over the weekend to register for a Tuesday morning distribution of breakfast and lunch bags for students at Newville Elementary School for Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; registrations are being taken through 11 a.m. March 19, for a second distribution on Thursday March 20 designed to provide meals for Friday, Monday and Tuesday.

## **Camp Hill School District**

The West Shore School District will offer Free Grab-and-Go Bagged Meals for children starting Tuesday, March 17 through Friday, March 27 from 11 a.m. till 1 p.m., Monday through Friday, at four designated locations. No questions will be asked; however, following current federal guidelines children must be present to receive the bagged meals.

If driving, please remain in your vehicle and use extreme caution when arriving and leaving to ensure the safety of other participants. As a reminder, during this time building and school facilities (including playground equipment) are closed.
