Central Dauphin School District

Central Dauphin School District will be providing free grab and go breakfast and lunch meals to any resident children aged 18 and under. Any child, 18 or under, who lives within the boundaries of Central Dauphin School District will be eligible for free breakfast and lunch. The CHILD MUST BE PRESENT in order to receive the meal due to National School Lunch Program reimbursement guidelines. Meal distribution beginning March 17th, every weekday between 8:30am – 11:00am.
